## **Turn by turn directions to Littlefield Farm 15314 Stehr Rd., Arlington, WA**

### **From I-5 coming from Seattle-Everett area:**

Take exit 194 for US-2 E toward Snohomish/Wenatchee

Continue onto US-2 E

Merge onto WA-204 E toward Lake Stevens for 2.1mi

At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto WA-9 N for.1mi

At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit and stay on WA-9 N for 1.6mi

Turn right onto WA-92 E for.6

At the traffic circle, continue straight to stay on WA-92 E for .9mi

At the traffic circle, continue straight to stay on WA-92 E for 4.2mi

Turn left onto 161st Ave NE for .3mi

Turn left onto 163rd Ave NE for 1.1mi

Turn left onto 100th St NE/Burn Rd and follow Burn rd for 1.2mi

Turn left onto 116th Street NE for.2mi

Slight right onto Burn Rd for 1.8mi

Turn right onto Stehr Rd and follow it to the end. The house is on the left

There will be signs!

### **From I-5 Coming from North of Everett**

Take exit 208 toward State Hwy/Silvana Arlington

Turn left onto WA-530 E

At the traffic circle, continue straight to stay on WA-530 E

At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit to stay on WA-530

Turn right onto WA-9 S

Turn left onto E Highland Dr for

Turn right onto S Stillaguamish Ave

Slight left onto Burn Rd/Burn Hill Rd

Turn left to stay on Burn Rd/Burn Hill Rd

Turn left onto Stehr Rd continue to the end and the house is on the left.

There will be signs.
