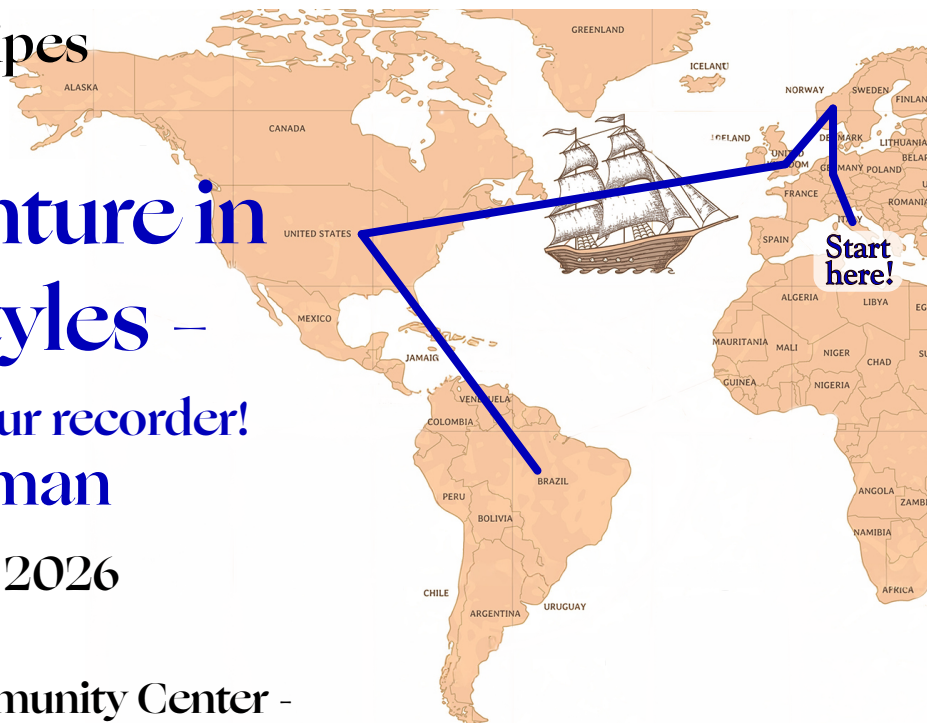

Come enjoy the music of Biumi, Bruckner, Bach, Grieg, Barroso, and the infamous anonymous, as we play clever arrangements by her brilliant Seattle colleagues Peter Seibert, Charles Coldwell, and Miguel Rode.

Vicki Boeckman has been performing and teaching since the 1980s. Before settling in Seattle, she resided in Denmark from 1981-2005 and had the opportunity to collaborate with some of the finest musicians and composers of the day. In the Pacific Northwest, Vicki has been a featured soloist with countless orchestras and ensembles and delights in collaborating in all styles. She is currently a member of the Farallon Recorder Quartet, Music Director for the Seattle Recorder Society, Artistic Director for the bi-annual Port Townsend Early Music Workshop, and co-director of the Recorder Orchestra of Puget Sound with Charles Coldwell. She adores teaching children as well as adults and has been on the faculty of Music Center of the Northwest since 2005 in addition to having a thriving home and Zoom studio. 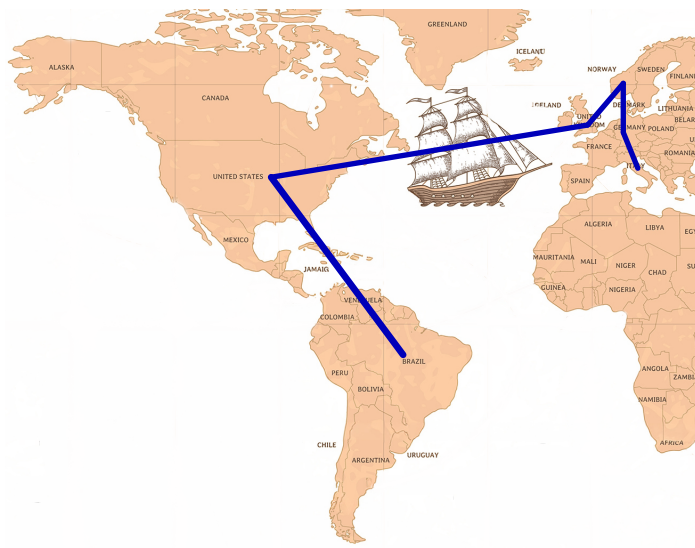
