

Software to slow down the pitch of recorded music (Digital Audio Workstations or “DAWs”), recommended by David Podeschi, May 2020

1. [Audacity](#): free, it has functionality for slowing down music without changing its pitch and is also a good entry level recording software solution. Because it is free, its recording functionality is limited vs. the other choices but is adequate for many users.
2. [Reaper](#): free 90 day trial period after which you must buy it for \$60. This is a more full featured DAW and the least expensive full featured DAW.
3. [Cubase Elements](#): full featured DAW, 30 day trial period, then pay \$99.
4. There are many single function apps that slow down music--but that is all they do. There is also [Garage Band](#), which is only compatible with Apple products.
